What You Need to Know When Buying Online from Abroad

Learn more about customs duties and taxes

eBay makes it easy to purchase items from virtually anywhere in the world, removing any borders between buyer and seller.

Here is some basic information about duties and taxes for purchases delivered to Israel, Norway or EU countries.

If you are in Israel



If you are in Norway



If you are in the EU



If you are in the EU and order from another country inside or outside the EU, different taxes apply based on the total cost of your purchase. Your total cost excludes shipping and customs duties.

While purchases under a certain threshold are often exempt from VAT and customs

duties, topacco products, perfumes or tollet waters and alcohol of any value are still subject to VAT and customs duties.

Ordering from any country within the EU



☆ Orders up to €22

If you order from any country within the EU and your total cost is up to €22 you pay no VAT or customs duties until 1 July 2021.

Threshold exceptions

While most EU countries apply the threshold of €22 or the equivalent amount in local currency, some EU countries maintain distinct thresholds.

Bulgaria	BGN 30 (about €15.34)
Croatia	HRK 160 (about €20.85)
Cyprus	€17
Denmark	DKK 80 (about €10.75)



☆ Orders of more than €22

If you order from another country within the EU and your total cost is more than €22 you have to pay VAT. There are different VAT rates applied in different countries.

Reduced valiates

Reduced VAT rates can be applied to some categories of goods like books, periodicals and food. Check if your item falls into one of these categories on the <u>official site of the European Commission</u>.

Ordering from any country outside the EU

If you order from non-EU countries and the total cost of your purchase is	You pay
up to €22*	no VAT or customs duties until 1 July 2021
from €22 to €150	only VAT (you do not pay customs duties)
over €150	both VAT and customs duties

Calculating customs duties

Customs duties are calculated as a percentage of the customs value of the goods. The customs value consists of: price of your item + insurance + shipping. You can find applicable tariffs in the <u>TARIC database</u>.

Excise duties

Excise duties are applied to some of the alcoholic beverages and tobacco products. For detailed information about excise duties, see **Excise duties on alcohol, tobacco and energy** on the official site of the European Commission.

Refunded purchases

If you paid tax through eBay and you get a refund for your order, you'll also get a refund for the proportionate amount of tax.



For example, if you receive a full refund, you'll get the entire tax back. If

you receive a 50% partial retund, you'll get 50% of the tax back.

Any refunds processed outside eBay's systems are not eligible for a tax refund.

If you paid import duties or taxes as part of clearing your package through customs but you then returned the item, please contact the customs authority regarding a refund of the charges.

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
